A BILL

To repeal certain amendments to the Energy Policy and Conservation Act with respect to lighting energy efficiency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Thomas Edison BULB
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIGHTING ENERGY EFFICIENCY.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subtitle B of title III of the En-
3 ergy Independence and Security Act of 2007 (Public Law
4 110–140) is repealed.

5 (b) APPLICATION.—The Energy Policy and Con-
6 servation Act (42 U.S.C. 6201 et seq.) shall be applied
7 and administered as if subtitle B of title III of the Energy
8 Independence and Security Act of 2007 (and the amend-
9 ments made by that subtitle) had not been enacted.

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
